- 7 Wed Holy Protomartyr and Equal-to-the-Apostles Thecla (I). Venerable Coprius of Palestine (530). Venerable King Stephen (1224) and his son and Vladislav the Serbians (1230-1239)

- 8 Thu Venerable Euphrosyne, nun, of Alexandria (V). Repose of Venerable Sergius, abbot, of Radonezh (1392). Martyr Paphnutius and 546 companions in Egypt (III)
- 9 Fri Repose of the Holy Apostle and Evangelist John the Theologian. (II). St. Tikhon, Patriarch of Moscow (1989).

- 10 Sat Martyr Callistratus and his company (49 Martyrs) of Carthage (304). Πρπ. Venerable Sabbatius, wonderworker of Solovki (1435). Apostles Mark, Aristarchus, and Zenas of the Seventy.

15 Thu Hieromartyr Cyprian, Virgin-martyr Justina and Martyr Theoctist of Nicomedia (304). Blessed Andrew, fool-for-Christ at Constantinople (936). St. Theodore of Sanaskar (Ushakov), admiral of the Russian Navy (1717).

16 Fri Hieromartyr Dionysius (Dennys) the Areopagite, and with him Martyrs Rusticus and Eleutherius (96). Venerable John the Chozebite, bishop of Caesarea in Palestine (VI).

17.00 Vespers, Memorial Service

17 Sat Hieromartyr Hierotheus, bishop of Athens (I). Martyrs Gaius, Faustus, Eusebius, and Chaeremon of Alexandria (III). МЦЦ. Martyrs Domnina and her daughters Berenice (Bernice) and Prosdoce, of Syria (306).

17.00 All-Night Vigil

18 Sun **19th Sunday after Pentecost.** Charitina of Amisus (304). Sts. Peter (1326), Theognostus (1353), Alexis (1378), Cyprian (1406), Photius (1431), Jonah (1461), Gerontius (1489), Ioasaph (1555), Macarius (1563), Philip (1569), Job (1607), Hermogenes (Germogen) (1612), Tikhon (1925), Peter (1937), Philaret (1867), Innocent (Veniaminov) (1879), and Macarius (1563), metropolitans of Moscow.

25 Sun **20th Sunday after Pentecost.** Commemoration of the Holy Fathers of the Seventh Ecumenical Council (787). Martyrs Probus, Tarachus, and Andronicus at Tarsus in Cilicia (304). Venerable Cosmas the Hymnographer, bishop of Maiuma (787).

26 Mon Conveying into Moscow of the Iveron Icon of the Most Holy Theotokos (1648). Martyrs Carpus, bishop at Thyateira, Papyrus the deacon, Agathadorus, and Agathonica at Pergamus (251). Venerable Benjamin of the Kiev Caves (421- 424).

27 Tue Martyrs Nazarius, Gervase, Protase, and Celsus of Milan (54-68). Venerable Parasceva (Petka) of Epibatima (XI).

28 Wed Venerable Euthymius the New of Thessalonica, monk of Mt. Athos (889). Martyr Lucian, presbyter of Greater Antioch (312).
